

The regular meeting for the month of July of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, July 11, 2022, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach and Dean Davis were present. Also present were Marilyn Zona, Tom Thompson, Paul Kremer, Jeremy Rice, Leo Waelchil, Jim Scheck and Mr. & Mrs. Griffen.

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the June 16, 2022 meeting, Alan Dambach seconded.

WATER: Jeremy Rice reported the new meter and valve in the North Sewickley pit was replaced. The electronics required quite a bit of work after the replacement. The Great Southern meter still needs replaced. Dean Davis reported on the bid received from Ryan Carrigan of Sunrise Electric to clean up the electric at the meter pit and install a dusk to dawn light, the bid is \$1925. Alan Dambach motioned to approve the bid from Sunrise Electric, Dean Davis seconded.

SEWAGE: The Township has been fined by DEP for exceeding effluent limitations at the Veka sewage treatment plant on dates ranging from 1/31/18 to 2/28/22. Tom Thompson, township engineer advised the board to appeal the fine to negotiate a reduced amount. The secretary will contact DEP for a meeting. Dean Davis motioned to adopt Resolution 2022-5, approval of signing of the Consent Assessment of Civil Penalty from DEP, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE Paul Kremer, plant operator and Tom Thompson will meet with Veka to discuss the problems with the discharge to the sewage treatment plant.

ROADS: The summer road work was discussed. Steinbach Road has been asphalted, the berms need to be filled. The signage on Herman Road bend is in place except for the flashing sign. Dean Davis motioned to advertise for snow removal for the 2022-2023 winter season, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

ENGINEER: No report.

PLANNING COMMISSION: The Commission is working on a wind energy ordinance

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of May – none. Dean Davis motioned to confirm and sign the Conditional Use for the Novaley Day Spa, Alan Dambach seconded. ADAYE DDAYE TGAYE The Kopp enforcement notice has been received and they have 30 days to correct the problems on the properties. If corrective action has not been taken the supervisors will vote to file with the District Magistrate. The Spencer enforcement notice was received and corrective action has already been completed. Penn Energy has filed with DEP to place holding tanks on the property they own along the Connoquenessing. The Supervisors will look over the paperwork and discuss at the next meeting.

SOLICITOR: No report.

Leo Waelchli spoke to the board about his concerns of the semi trucks waiting to load or unload at the wood treatment plant. He is very concerned that an accident might occur. Trucks were parked where it was illegal. New Sewickley police handled the situation.
