

The regular meeting for the month of July of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, July 9, 2018, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach and Dean Davis were present. Also present were Chris Reese, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Billie Jo Blinn, Barb Blinn, Kristi Mawhinney, Doug Rice, Roy Raida and Amy Dorra.

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the June 12, 2018 Agricultural Security Hearing and the regular monthly meeting, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

WATER: The fire hydrants will be trimmed around and painted if needed. The awarding of the grant that the Township applied for a waterline extension on Herman Road has been delayed until September.

SEWAGE: The Secretary will check with Paul Kremer on his anticipated expenditures for the rest of the year.

ROADS: The Township will contact the Blinn Brothers for the work that needs done on the unpaved portion of Ben Venue.

ENGINEER: No report

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of June, 2018 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 315.5 hours, Total Calls: 26, Mutual aid: 0, Traffic arrests: 6. The Chief will contact Penn Dot concerning the safety of the Canoe Launch at the intersection of Pine Run and Route 588

PLANNING COMMISSION: Mr. Rice reported that the Live Out Baptist Church is in the planning stages of expansion. The Commission is still working on the Junk Yard/Scrap Ordinance.

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of June - none

SOLICITOR: Billie Jo Blinn reported to the Supervisors that Mazza Engineering will have the submission into MDIA by noon Tuesday, July 10. The Richardson Conditional Use Application is incomplete. The Township needs a drawing of the plans for screening etc., the size of their lot, parking plans and for which Conditional Use they are applying.

The tenant of our rental house will be leaving. The Supervisors want to know by the August meeting if she is leaving by September 1st.

Supervisor George expressed concerns over the condition of Brush Creek Park and the County's lack of care and maintenance and police patrol. The Township is going to check into grants and contact the County.

Community Day has been changed to the 3rd Saturday in August, the 18th due to personnel needs.

Kristi Mawhinney addressed the Board over concerns with her subdivision and the rejection of DEP of her Planning Module. The first rejection was March 26th, it was resubmitted and rejected again at the end of April. She is waiting for the latest rejection and now needs to do further testing. The Supervisors explained that the Township has no control in regards to sewage testing and DEP approval.

Dean Davis motioned to pay the bills, Tom George seconded. Roll Call: Mr. George-yes, Mr. Dambach-yes, Mr. Davis-yes.

The Supervisors went into executive session at 6:15 p.m. for personnel reasons and returned at 6:40 p.m.
