

The regular meeting for the month of June of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Thursday, June 16, 2022, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George and Alan Dambach were present, Supervisor Dean Davis was absent. Also present were Mike Pszenny, Marilyn Zona, Tom Thompson, Mr. & Mrs. Griffen, Amanda Peterson, Phyllis Szulczewski, and Shawn English.

Alan Dambach motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the May 9, 2022 meeting, Tom George seconded. TGAYE ADAYE

WATER: The new meter and valve in the North Sewickley pit will be replaced Monday May 16th. The Great Southern meter still needs replaced. The grant submitted for Herman Road will be awarded in the fall.

SEWAGE: The quarterly report issue with Veka has been resolved.

ROADS: The summer road work was discussed. Steinbach Road drainage work has been done and is ready for asphalt. Hart Road has been tar and chipped and the drainage completed. Phyllis Szulczewski from Eckert Stop Lane requested the supervisors donate a load of stone for the road. Alan Dambach motioned to donate a triaxle of stone for Eckert Stop Lane because the township owns property on the lane, Tom George seconded. ENGINEER: No report.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of May, 2022 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 295 hours, Total Calls: 36, Mutual aid: 4, New Sewickley: 20 calls. The traffic problems and creek problems from kayakers was discussed. The chief has contact the Fish and Boat Commission, Penn Power, and Allegheny Aquatic Alliance. Violations will result in arrests.

PLANNING COMMISSION: The Township will apply for a grant with Franklin and North Sewickley Townships to update our Comprehensive Plan. The Township will have 3 members on a committee that will work with an engineering firm on the update.

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of May – Frank Rice- addition to garage. The Zoning Officer will survey the Township for sizes of home occupation signs and other business signs. The Zoning Officer will check with the solicitor on a timeline for the Kopp zoning enforcement issue.
