

The special meeting of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order at 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 19, 2019 at the municipal building. Supervisors Tom George and Alan Dambach were present. Also present were Marilyn Zona, Michael Pszenny, Frank Evanson, Eric Brewer, Frank Paris, P J Moldvan and Dave Kopp.

Eric Brewer explained that Emergency Management is governed by State Title 35. There are 3 main areas that the Township needs to address. Number 1- is an Emergency Operation Plan, 2- an Emergency Operation Center and 3 - is Training. Eric gave the Supervisors and the Township EMC, Dave Kopp a generic plan that they can use to create a plan for the Township. He offered to give us help in creating our plan. Mr. Kopp has taken his basic training and attends quarterly meetings for updates.

Mr. Kopp is going to compile a list of residents in the flood prone areas and their phone numbers for use during flooding.

Mr. Brewer explained that only the elected officials can announce an evacuation order. Residents cannot be forced to leave their homes.

P J Moldvan expressed to the Supervisors how important visible reflective house numbers are in emergency situations. He asked that if we do not have an ordinance requiring house number signs, that the Township should adopt one.

The Supervisors went into executive session at 5 p.m. to discuss police personnel and returned at 5:30 p.m.

Alan Dambach motioned to accept the resignation with regret of Frank Evanson as Police Chief effective July 6, 2019 and appoint Michael Pszenny as Acting Chief at his current rate, Tom George seconded. TGAYE ADAYE
