

The regular meeting for the month of June of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, June 8, 2020, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Dean Davis and Alan Dambach were present, Supervisor Tom George was absent. Also present were Chris Reese, Michael Pzenny, William Hummel, Marilyn Zona, Brent Robinson and Dave Kopp.

Alan Dambach motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of May 11, 2020 meeting, Dean Davis seconded.  
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**WATER:** The remote at the Honeywell building at the school needs replaced. The list of the 10 meters we will use for the Advanced metering system has not been made. Jeremy Rice will meet with Ken McLaughlin from National Road to begin verifying the meters to be used with the system. Bill Carboni from Dambach Lane is concerned that there might be a water leak near his property. The mother board and radio from the Mission System had to be replaced.

**SEWAGE:** No report

**ROADS:** The Road Inspection Report was reviewed. The Supervisors will get an estimate from Jeremy Rice for: Steinbach Road- patch holes and level sink hole, Ben Venue paved end- clean ditches, Bridge Drive- patch edge, Veka Drive – fill holes at bend, Herman Road – driveways, Hart Road – patch holes berms, Nagel Road – clean ditch, Mecklem Road – ditches, Glendale Road – concrete ditch and pave edges. The Supervisors will get an estimate from the Blinn Bros for Ben Venue Road – lower end fill holes and clean ditches. The Supervisors will wait until next year to seal Mecklem and Ben Venue Roads.

**ENGINEER:** No report.

**POLICE:** The Police Report for the month of May, 2020 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 359 hours, Total Calls: 36, Mutual aid: 0, New Sewickley: 7 calls. The Chief discussed the speed data from the solar speed sign. There were 10,480 cars that used Herman Road in the month of May. The Chief discussed the problems in the Township with young people trespassing on railroad property and jumping off the railroad bridge. He also discussed the problems with traffic and parking at the Hartzell School kayak launch. He discussed his ideas of building a pavilion on the property that the Township owns on Eckert Stop Lane.

**PLANNING COMMISSION:** The Commission asked that the Supervisors re-review the Junk, scrap, auto salvage Draft Ordinance that the Commission presented to the Supervisors some time ago.

**ZONING:** Building permits issued in the month of May – none.

**SOLICITOR:** Attorney Reese spoke with Susan Buckman concerning the Blinn Venue. There has been no movement.

Supervisors Dambach reported that Trash day was a huge success.

The Supervisors are still considering having Community Day on August 15, 2020.
