

The regular meeting for the month of March of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, March 8, 2021, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Dean Davis, Thomas George and Alan Dambach were present. Also present were Chris Reese, Michael Pszenny, Marilyn Zona, Jeremy Rice, Roy Raida and Amanda Peterson.

Alan Dambach motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the February 8, 2021 meeting, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE

WATER: Jeremy Rice reported to the Board that the Honeywell Office meter has not been replaced with Beacon. He also reported that the repair from the waterline break of February 10th seems to be holding. Tom George motioned to purchase a GPS data collector from Precision Laser and Instrument, Inc. for not more than \$2,400, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

PLANNING COMMISSION: Roy Raida discussed with the Supervisors the solar ordinance that the Planning Commission is working on. The Planning Commission does not want to permit solar farms anywhere but the Industrial district. SOLICITOR: Attorney Reese reported there has been not movement on House Bill 1037. The Supervisors will continue to wait for a resolution to House Bill 1037 before making a decision on the Blinn property.
