

The regular meeting for the month of May of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, May 10, 2021, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Dean Davis, Thomas George and Alan Dambach were present. Also present were Chris Reese, Michael Pszenny, Marilyn Zona, Tom Thompson, Jeremy Rice, Roy Raida, Mike Jacobs and Sherry Szakelyhidi.

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the April 12, 2021 meeting, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE

WATER: Jeremy Rice reported to the Board that the Honeywell Office meter has not been replaced with Beacon. Alan Dambach motioned to replace the Filbert meter pit on Dambach Lane, then send a letter to the Filberts explaining that they will be responsible for the pit going forward, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE The Township is still checking on a meter for the YMCA and new valve for the North Sewickley pit.

SEWAGE: Dean Davis motioned to approve and sign the Becker Sewage Agreement and sign and send the Becker Planning Module when completed, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

ROADS: Road Inspection report was submitted as follows: Steinbach Road – cut berms, patch holes, Mueller Hill Road – cut ditch, Ben Venue Road – lower end- fill holes and grade ditches, paved side – patch holes, clean ditches, Bridge Drive – clean ditches. West Road – ok, Veka Drive – fill holes on bend, Herman Road – clean berms, Petrie Road – ok, Hart Road – tar and chip, clean berms, Nagel Road – ok, Mecklem Road – clean ditches, pave upper end, Householder Road – ok, Glendale Road – Downhill side. Jeremy Rice will give estimates on the normal maintenance work. The Township will check with New Sewickley to see if we can piggy back for the tar and chip on Hart Road using Youngblood Paving. Tom Thompson, Township engineer, told the board that the estimated amount to pave Mecklem would be \$36000. Dean Davis motioned to advertise for bids for Mecklem Road paving, Alan Dambach seconded. POLICE: The Police Report for the month of April, 2021 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 306 hours, Total Calls: 26, Mutual aid: 1, New Sewickley: 9 calls. PLANNING COMMISSION: Roy Raida discussed with the Supervisors the solar ordinance that the Planning Commission was working on. Some of the items discussed: A solar farm the electric goes straight to the power grid, small scale solar system is for owner use, roof top is a permitted use, ground base must have a conditional use permit, a solar farm make larger setbacks. Alan Dambach motioned to advertise for adoption the Scrap/junk yard Ordinance, Dean Davis seconded. ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of April – Frank Kocher – deck, Jason Dambach – addition and renovation.

SOLICITOR: Attorney Reese advised the Board that there has been little movement Senate bill 191 concerning building laws for historic barns. The House has not moved on their bill for the same thing. The Supervisors will continue to wait for a resolution.

Trash Day is May 22, 2021.

No one has come forward to chair Community Day.

The Township rental property has a tenant.

Sherry Szakelyhidi spoke to the Supervisors concerning the problems of trespassing on her property and the railroad bridge on the creek. She wanted the Supervisors to be aware that the problems have already begun. She was told to call 9-1-1 and request police presence. Chief Pszenny told the Supervisors and Mrs. Szakelyhidi that they will do all that they can lawfully to help the situation.
