

The regular meeting for the month of May of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, May 11, 2020, at 4:00 p.m., on a Zoom Internet conference. Supervisors Thomas George, Dean Davis and Alan Dambach were all present via Zoom teleconference. Also present on Zoom were Chris Reese, Michael Pzenny, William Hummel. Roy Raida and Marilyn Zona.

WATER: The remote at the Honeywell building at the school needs replaced. Supervisors George will make a list of the 10 meters we will use for the Advanced metering system.

SEWAGE: No report

ROADS: The Supervisors will hold Road Inspection on Thursday May 14, 2020 at 9:00 A.M. The railroad is doing the needed repairs on West Road Bridge. Supervisors Dambach secured 6 loads of millings from the Brush Creek Park road work.

Supervisor George asked that the Chief monitor the intersection of Route 588 and West Road, the trucks are parking too close to the intersection.

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of April – none.

SOLICITOR: Attorney Reese spoke with Susan Buckman concerning the Blinn Venue. The Bill concerning building laws for Historic Barns was moved off the table but is still active.
