

The regular meeting for the month of May of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, May 13, 2019, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Dean Davis and Alan Dambach were present. Also present were Chris Reese, Marilyn Zona, Frank Evanson, Roy Raida, Bill Hummel, Barb Blinn, Billie Jo Blinn, Charles Blinn, Elmer Blinn, Amy Gonzalez, Dave Kopp, Lorre Adams, and Mike Myers.

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the April 8, 2019 meeting, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE

ROADS: The bids for the Petrie Road Paving project were opened. Youngblood Paving was low bidder, Unit Price: 6.34 for a total of \$68,345.20, Shields Asphalt, Unit Price: 6.68 for a total of \$72,010.40, Protech Asphalt, Unit Price: 6.99 for a total of \$75,352.20, and A. Folino, Unit Price: 8.10 for a total of \$87,318.00. After discussion with Engineer Hummel, Dean Davis motioned to accept Youngblood Paving's bid of \$68,345.20, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE Mr. Rice reported that the Herman Road project is done. Supervisor Davis reported that he checked Herman Road during the rain and the project side is working great but that he feels the west side needs drainage work. He will meet with Jeremy Rice and Bill Hummel at the site to discuss it. The Supervisors reviewed Dirt Worx estimate for road work. It totaled \$4900. WATER: Supervisor George will try to have the electrician install the surge protector and ground rod for the meter pit. The parts list is done and was given to the Supervisors.

SEWAGE: No report

ENGINEER: Mr. Hummel advised the Supervisors that the Airport Runway Rehabilitation Project complies with the Marion Township Flood Plain Ordinance. Alan Dambach motioned to approve the compliance with Marion Township's Flood Plain Ordinance of the Airport Runway Rehabilitation project and send a letter stating that, Dean Davis seconded. SOLICITOR: Susan Bucknum called into the meeting again to discuss the Blinn Venue and the recent legislation that is before the State Congress. The legislation would exempt historic barns from UCC regulations but provide for certain reports and affidavits. Alan Dambach motioned to allow the Blinn's to operate their Venue for the next month and revisit this at the June meeting for an update on the legislation, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

PLANNING COMMISSION: The Commission reviewed the Frank Rice Conditional Use Application for a repair garage for dirt bikes and ATV's. ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of April – none

SOLICITOR: The Solicitor reported that the County Solicitor, Sheriff and Public Works Director met with Marion and North Sewickley Township concerning Brush Creek Park. Supervisor Dambach, Secretary Zona and Chief Evanson represented Marion Township. The Sheriff is going to try and patrol the park again and lock the park at night, Monday thru Friday. The County is checking to see if Act 13 money can be used to pave the road. They are going to try and apply for grants for a new playground. They are going to clean some trenches and pipe and gravel them as weather permits. They have 4 full time employees working at the park and in the summer they just mow grass. The Solicitor reported that the West Road Bridge hearing will start on Monday, June 24, 2019 in Pittsburgh.

The Supervisors will dye test the septic at the Rental.
