

The regular meeting for the month of May of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, May 14, 2018, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Dean Davis and Alan Dambach were present. Also present were Chris Reese, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Doug Rice, Jeremy Rice, Billie Jo Blinn, Barb Blinn, Roy Raida, Jacqueline Mazza and Dave Kopp.

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the April 9, 2018 meeting, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE

WATER: The fence gate around the water tower needs some maintenance. Jeremy Rice reported that the water break at the Sheerer residence was a rotted meter.

SEWAGE: The Township will contact Veka concerning the Budget for the Sewage Plant. They will ask for a one time correction of \$3,000 and the Supervisors will recalculate the expenses and adjust the fee accordingly.

ROADS: The spring road report was discussed. Steinbach Road- clean ditches and fill potholes, Muller Hill Road - fill potholes, Ben Venue Road – fill potholes and clean ditches lower end, Clean ditches paved end, Bridge Drive – ok, West Road – fill berms east side, Veka Drive – millings on bend, Petrie Road – grade and clean ditches across from Barenfelds, grade both sides of Petrie, Hart Road- grade berm, Nagel Road – ok, Mecklem Road – upper end Penn Energy, Householder Road – ok. The Supervisors reviewed the quote from Dirt Worx for the work to be done on Herman Road Bend. Alan Dambach motioned to approve and accept the quote from Dirt Worx for \$16,000 to improve the drainage on the bend on Herman Road, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of April, 2018 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 339.5 hours, Total Calls: 20, Mutual aid: 1. Chief Evanson will set up a meeting with New Sewickley to discuss merger/shared services/contract.

PLANNING COMMISSION: The Planning Commission is continuing to rewrite the junk ordinance. Roy Raida presented all the paperwork that the Planning Commission has on the Dan Johnson/Valerie Weber deposition.

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of April to David Barenfeld for an addition to his house on Hartzell School Road and Derek McNeill for a storage building.

SOLICITOR: The Supervisors decided to send Attorney Reese with Doug Rice to the Johnson/Weber deposition. Billie Jo Blinn spoke to the Board about the Blinn Event Venue. She has taken over the process of bringing the Venue into compliance. Jacqueline Mazza, the engineer for the project presented the Supervisors with a letter outlining their plans. They have asked for an extension to the May 1, 2018 deadline while they send their new plans to MDIA. They will remove all doors on the barn and make it an open air pavilion until they receive approval and building permit. Alan Dambach motioned to allow the Blinn Event Venue to continue with scheduled events with the doors removed from the barn, and the Blinn's will provide monthly updates on the progress, Dean Davis seconded.
