

The regular meeting for the month of November of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, November 11, 2019, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Dean Davis and Alan Dambach were present. Supervisor Thomas George was absent. Also present were Chris Reese, Marilyn Zona, Bill Hummel, Amy Gonzalez, Brian Perry, Ron Leindecker and Dave Kopp.

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the October 14, 15 and 16, 2019 meetings, Alan Dambach seconded. DDAYE ADAYE

New Sewickley Police Chief, Ron Leindecker, attended the meeting to discuss the calls and how his department is handling patrol in our Township per the contract. Since October 20th their department handled 10 calls of which 3 were accidents.

WATER: Bill Norris installed a surge protector at the meter pit. A ground rod was already in place.

SEWAGE: No report.

ROADS: The dirt side work of Ben Venue has been completed. The Supervisors discussed getting a price on tree trimming for the paved side of Ben Venue. Supervisors Davis is going to talk to R & B Tree Trimming. The problems with speed on Herman Road was discussed. Police Chief Pszeny advised the Board that proper speed limits would need to be posted on the road before the Police can enforce them. The Township Police will study the road to post proper speed limits. Traffic calmers were also discussed.

ENGINEER: No report.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of October, 2019 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 344.5 hours, Total Calls: 31, Mutual aid: 1. Alan Dambach motioned to add a line item in the 2020 General Fund Budget for overtime for the Police and place \$2,000 on that line item, Dean Davis seconded. ADAYE DDAYE

PLANNING COMMISSION: The Supervisors approved and signed the Wenzel Plan of subdivision on a motion by Alan Dambach, seconded by Dean Davis. ADAYE DDAYE

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of October – Hickman- deck and shower.

SOLICITOR: Attorney Reese advised the Board that House Bill 1037 concerning Historical barns and the building code was laid on the table and removed which is standard practice. Alan Dambach motioned to extend the decision on the Blinn Venue until March 30, 2020, Dean Davis seconded. ADAYE DDAYE

A report on the Brush Creek Park Committee was given by Marilyn Zona.

The General, State, Water and Sewage Budgets for the year 2020 were read by Marilyn Zona. Alan Dambach motioned to advertise the Proposed Marion Township 2020 Budget for viewing and adoption at the December 9, 2019 Supervisors meeting, Dean Davis seconded. ADAYE DDAYE

The Emergency Management Plan for the Township was presented to the Supervisors for adoption by David Kopp, the Township Emergency Management Coordinator. Alan Dambach motioned to adopt Resolution 2019-2 the Marion Township Emergency Management Plan with the attachment of the Call List, Dean Davis seconded. ADAYE DDAYE

Alan Dambach motioned to pay the bills, Dean Davis seconded. Roll Call: Mr. Davis – yes Mr. Dambach – yes.
