WATER: No report.

SEWAGE: Frank Bair from Veka thanked the Supervisors for amending the Boron limit in the Sewer Users Agreement. Paul Kremer would like the Supervisors to appoint an Alternate Operator for the Sewage Plant.

ROAD REPORT: The Penn Energy, Ben Venue Road Improvement is complete with the exception of the pipe across the road at the driveway to the gas well. The bonding of Ben Venue has not been received. Nagel Road has been paved.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of October was submitted and approved as follows: Total Hours worked: 327 hours, Total calls: 26, Traffic stops: 3, Mutual aid: 1. The Chief and Assistant Chief have been accepted into the Beaver County Police Chiefs Association. The black police vehicle was wrecked and has been repaired.

PLANNING COMMISSION: Roy Raida reported the Commission is in the final stages of completion of the updating of the Zoning Ordinance. The Chappel subdivision was presented to the Supervisors. Alan Dambach motioned to approve the Chappel Subdivision subject to completion of the Non-building Waiver request to DEP and the County Approval, Dean Davis seconded. Attorney Reese reported an agreement with the Township, Veka, Big Knob Fire Department, Harmony Fire District, and the 911 Center has been reached. He hopes to have the Agreement for the Supervisors to sign at the December meeting.

The 2018 Proposed Marion Township Budgets were presented and read: General Fund: Total available- \$621,200, Total Expenses- 361,100, State Fund: Total available- \$55,449, Total expenses- \$55,449, Water Fund: Total available- \$645,600, Total expenses- \$265,672, Sewage Fund: Total available- \$53,168, Total expenses- \$49,435. There will be no tax increase with this Budget. Dean Davis motioned to advertise the Proposed 2018 Budgets for viewing and adoption, the adoption to be on December 11, 2017, Alan Dambach seconded.
