

The regular meeting for the month of November of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, November 14, 2022, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach and Dean Davis were present. Also present were Marilyn Zona, Mike Pzenny, Tom Thompson, Amanda Peterson, Jeremy Rice, Roy Raida, Dave Kopp, Bob Rice, Robin Fry and Kathleen Griffen.

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the October 10, 25, and 26, 2022 meetings, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

WATER: The hydrants have been flushed and the line across the bridge drained. The problem with water loss has been resolved. The YMCA camp meter was reading in the 100,000's instead of 1,000,000's. They were billed for 610,000 gallons of water since 5/1/2022 and should have been billed 6,100,000 gallons. The Township will meet with officials from the Camp to resolve the issue. The Township will be replacing long service lines with meter pits at the curb stop. The Supervisors voted to increase the water rate at their October 26, 2022 budget meeting. They will vote by resolution at the December meeting to increase the rate to \$7.60/1000 gallons beginning with January water use.

SEWAGE: The NPDES renewal has not been received.

ROADS: The Conservation District will do more studies on the gravel end of Ben Venue Road before applying for the grant. Jeremy Rice will clear the ditches on all roads of leaves. The Township will order delineators for Householder, Mecklem and Petrie Roads for the snow removal crew.

ENGINEER: Tom Thompson reported that the Township has not received any word on the grant for Herman Road waterline and there is a new grant needing filed by December.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of October, 2022 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 314 hours, Total Calls: 20, New Sewickley: 7 Mutual aid: 2. Alan Dambach motioned to approve the contract with New Sewickley Police for the year 2023 in the amount of \$27,325, the amount was included in the budget for 2023, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE The police need to buy highway cones for their use.

PLANNING COMMISSION: Roy Raida presented the Bob Rice planned addition to his garage in the I-1 district. The Commission approved the plan. Alan Dambach motioned to approve Bob Rice's planned addition, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE The Supervisors discussed the Wind Energy draft Ordinance that the Planning Commission is working on.

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of October – Bob Hart- addition to house. The house at 1174 Route 588 owned by Dave Kopp that was demolished needs cleared. Mr. Kopp is going to burn it.

SOLICITOR: There has been no movement on the House Bill concerning the Blinn Wedding Venue.

The reading of the 2023 General, State, Sewage, and Water Budgets were presented and read by the secretary. Dean Davis motion to advertise the proposed 2023 Budgets for adoption on December 12, 2022, Alan Dambach seconded.

The Township no longer needs a recycler. Veronica Reyer is going to continue.

Dean Davis motion to approve and sign a contract with Govunity to build a new website for the Township at a cost of \$3900 plus \$360/year for web hosting, this was placed in the 2023 budget, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE
