

The regular meeting for the month of November of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, November 8, 2021, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Dean Davis and Alan Dambach were present. Also present were Chris Reese, Michael Pzenny, Marilyn Zona, Tom Thompson, Jeremy Rice, Amanda Peterson, Jim Scheck, Kathleen Griffin, Nick Vercilla and Barb Blinn.

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the October 11, 18 and 19, 2021 meetings, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE

WATER: The rules and regulations for the Water Department were reviewed and Tom Thompson will have the final version ready for review for the next meeting. The rules and regulations will be adopted by ordinance. The remaining meters and valves that need replaced were discussed.

SEWAGE: Alan Dambach motioned to approve and sign the Sewage agreement with Austin Ridgley for his existing sewage system, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

ROADS: Dean Davis motioned to approve and accept the Costar's contract with Cargill for salt for snow removal at a price of 68.52/ton, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of October, 2021 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 341 hours, Total Calls: 33, Mutual aid: 1, New Sewickley: 14 calls. Penn Energy has graciously donated an AED to the police department, Amanda Peterson, representing Penn Energy, presented the AED to the police department and supervisors. Alan Dambach motioned to accept and sign the 2022 agreement with the New Sewickley Police Department at \$26,525/year, \$2,210.42/month, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

PLANNING COMMISSION: Dean Davis motioned to adopt and sign Ordinance 2021-3, Solar Energy Ordinance, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of October - none

SOLICITOR: Attorney Reese reported that Senate Bill 191 concerning building laws for historic barns is still with Labor and Industry for review. The Supervisors will continue to wait for a resolution.

Alan Dambach motioned to appoint Jim Scheck as Marion Township's Emergency Management Coordinator replacing Dave Kopp, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE The proper paperwork will be sent to the County Emergency Management and then approval by the Governor.

Supervisor George reported that the new storage shed is on order and Supervisors Davis reported that he is getting a bid on painting the municipal building.
