

The regular meeting for the month of October of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, October 10, 2022, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, and Dean Davis were present. Supervisor Alan Dambach was present by phone as the Zoom was not working. Also present were Marilyn Zona, Mike Pszeny, Tom Thompson, Amanda Peterson, Jeremy Rice, Roy Raida, Dave Kopp and Jay and Kathleen Griffen.

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the September 12, 2022 meeting, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

WATER: The problem with water loss has not been resolved. Jeremy Rice is going to install the port to have the main meter at North Sewickley pit tested. He will also reach out to the new electric person for the Mission equipment. The Secretary will check with North Sewickley and ask if they had the same increase in there consumption from Beaver Falls. The leak at the water tower has been fixed. The hydrants still need flushed and the line across the bridge needs drained.

SEWAGE: The NPDES renewal has not been received.

ROADS: The Supervisors discussed the gravel end of Ben Venue Road and what portion the Township should apply for the Dirt and Gravel Road Grant. Dean Davis motion to apply to drain the storm water from the upper portion of Ben Venue Road and then surface improvement, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE Jeremy Rice will patch the loose pavement on Ben Venue paved portion.

ENGINEER: Tom Thompson reported that the Township has not received any word on the grant for Herman Road waterline and there is a new grant needing filed by December.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of September, 2022 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 327.50 hours, Total Calls: 34, New Sewickley: 11 Mutual aid: 0. The department received a grant from the County, Cares Act Money, for \$2,471. The Supervisors received the 2023 contract from New Sewickley. The Supervisors will consider it at the budget meetings.

PLANNING COMMISSION: The Commission is working on the wind energy ordinance.

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of September – none. The house at 1174 Route 588 owned by Dave Kopp has been demolished. Mr. Kopp is waiting to hear from the fire department about burning the demolition. Dean Davis motioned to give Mr. Kopp until November 30, 2022 to clear the rubble from the demo and until June 30, 2023 to demo the building at the bottom of his driveway at 1192 Route 588 or repair it, Alan Dambach seconded. SOLICITOR: There has been no movement on the House Bill concerning the Blinn Wedding Venue.

The Chief will try and get keys from Veka for the gate by the West Road bridge.
