

The regular meeting for the month of September of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, September 10, 2018, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Dean Davis and Alan Dambach were present. Also present were Chris Reese, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Roy Raida, Jim Marshall, Dave Kopp, Kristy Mawhinney and Ross Jenny.

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the August 13, 2018 regular monthly meeting, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE

State Representative Jim Marshall attended the meeting and the Supervisors spoke to him about the deplorable condition of Brush Creek County Park asking for any information or help he may be able to give. The Supervisors need to attend a work session of the Beaver County Commissioners. Solicitor Reese is going to continue researching the deeds.

Kristy Mawhinney addressed the Board concerning the septic testing of property she is trying to subdivide. She is having further testing on October 23, 2018 at 8:00 a.m. and will be using Ron Andrasko to do the testing instead of our SEO, Colleen Berg. She needs our SEO to sign off on Ron Andrasko's testing and is asking the Supervisors to appoint an Alternate SEO to sign off because she does not want to use Colleen Berg. The Supervisors explained that we do not have an alternate and it is unlikely that we will find someone for this project. Solicitor Reese is going to talk to DEP in Pittsburgh and ask that the Township not be required to sign off on this Planning Module since our SEO will not be a part of the testing.

WATER: The Supervisors agreed to raise the floor in the North Sewickley meter pit so it will drain and install a dehumidifier in the pit. The mother board that that was sent by Mission Communications but was not used will be purchased by the Township as a backup. The Secretary will check with Jeremy Rice on a list of spare parts that should be purchased by the water department. The Secretary will send a letter to Dave Kopp outlining the payback of the overdue water from his home at 1177 Route 588.

SEWAGE: No report.

ROADS: The Herman Road project still needs completed. The lone bid for snow removal was opened. Jenny LTD bid \$85.00/hour. Alan Dambach motioned to accept the bid from Jenny LTD for snow removal on the Township roads, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

PLANNING COMMISSION: The Commission is still working on the Junk Yard/Scrap Ordinance. Ed Boots introduced a junk yard ordinance that will be a good base for the Commission to work with. The Baptist Church attended their meeting to discuss their future plans. The church is working with an engineer for plans to present.

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of August –Ed Boots - porch

SOLICITOR: No report on the Blinn Event Center progress towards a building permit. There has been no movement on the Richardson or Frank Rice Conditional Use Applications. The Secretary will send letters to both giving 30 days to respond.

Community Options owns the home at 1404 Route 588 and the Township needs information from them about what the home is being used for. The Secretary will send a letter asking for a description of the use of the property.
