

The regular meeting for the month of September of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, September 12, 2022, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach and Dean Davis were present. Also present were Marilyn Zona, Tom Thompson, Amanda Peterson, Jeremy Rice and Kathleen Griffen.

Alan Dambach motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the August 8, 2022 meeting, Dean Davis seconded.

WATER: All large meters have been replaced. A letter needs to be sent to Great Southern advising that they need to place a permanent meter pit lid on meter pit. A water leak was found at the wood line and Dambach's field. A substantial maker must be place there for location purpose of the valve. Honeywell has complained of volume problems, although pressure is fine. All hydrants have been painted, lubed and new flags installed. They still need flushed and oiled. The Lukes household needs to provide meter readings to the Township, their readout is broken and they refuse entry to fix it.

SEWAGE: The DEP violation penalty has been resolved. The Township will pay \$2500, down from the original \$6500.

ROADS: the Township will meet with Hannah Ward from the Beaver County Conservation District on September 29 to continue the work to determine the info needed to apply for a grant for drainage work on the gravel part of Ben Venue Road. The Township needs to acquire keys from Veka to the gate at the West Road bridge.

ENGINEER: Tom Thompson reported that there is no news on the grant for a Herman Road waterline.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of August, 2022 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 336 hours, Total Calls: 36, New Sewickley: 14 Mutual aid: 0.

PLANNING COMMISSION: The Commission is working on a wind energy ordinance. The secretary suggested that the Commission take a look at regulations for Air B&B's.

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of August – W. Stang – demo, C. Stang – demo, VilJoen – revision, Kopp – enforcement. A new enforcement letter will be sent by the solicitor to David Kopp with final dates for resolution of his zoning violations.

SOLICITOR: There has been no movement on the House Bill concerning the Blinn Wedding Venue.
